**Notes:**

- ◆ All upper level nursing courses must be taken at Penn State. You will earn 33 credits for completion of your associate degree and earning your RN license. You will receive a complete check sheet identifying these courses when you meet with an advisor prior to applying for admission.
  
- ◆ First and second year HACC students with open elective slots should follow the list above closely. (For example if you have an open elective, you may want to choose Psychology 209, a direct transfer to Penn State). Always consult with your HACC advisor prior to selecting courses based on Penn State's list of requirements.
  
- ◆ Second year HACC students should call and schedule an appointment with a Penn State advisor in early spring to review transcripts and begin the admissions process. Most HACC students complete admission during summer sessions and begin classes in the fall. Day, evening, weekend, full and part-time options are available. Some web courses are also available.
  
- ◆ CHEM 012 and 014 (PSU) or CHEM 100 (HACC) is required by the Penn State School of Nursing but may be waived based on previous work. An advisor will discuss this once you are admitted to the program.

**Many courses at Penn State and HACC are available to meet general education requirements. Always check with an advisor prior to registering. This is a brief list of courses that are direct transfer for nursing. Additionally, course transfers do change, so check with an advisor to be absolutely certain.**
